The Institution Recycling Network has partnered with North Shore Recycled Fibers of Salem, Mass., to offer more recycling options.

The North Shore Fibers affiliation will allow North Shore clients in New England to recycle bottles, cans, computers and monitors, fluorescent lamps, scrap metal, plastics and other materials. IRN is a recycling cooperative that works with more than 200 colleges and universities, hospitals, schools and private companies to negotiate transportation, processing and marketing of reusable and recycled commodities.

IRN's OneStop recycling program simplifies the whole process, said Bob Heffernan of North Shore Fibers.

"It's what our customers have been asking for, especially in these tough economic times," he said. "Our clients want to do the right thing, but they have to make sure they're as efficient and cost-effective as possible
